#### **The Qualitative Research Intern**

The Qualitative Research Intern will support the Senior Research Associate in conducting a study about graduate outcomes of three Boston pilot schools where performance assessments are an integral part of the curriculum. The Qualitative Research Intern is responsible for research activities including:

- Conduct interviews with pilot school graduates about their experiences during and after attending a pilot school
- Contact graduates to arrange interviews
- Assist Senior Research Associate in the analysis of interview data
- Complete additional assignments, as needed.

#### **Qualifications**

The ideal candidate for the position of Qualitative Research Intern should have the following qualifications:

- Graduate student in education, evaluation, or relevant field
- Research experience or coursework in qualitative methods
- Ability to conduct interviews using the project interview protocol
- Strong analytical and communication skills
- Demonstrated commitment to equity in public education
- Strong organizational skills, ability to multi-task and complete projects by deadline
