

## **Massachusetts Campus Compact's Service-Learning in Teacher Education Initiative**

Seven faculty members were chosen to be part of a community of educators seeking to incorporate service-learning instruction within Education Departments throughout the state. As part of the effort, faculty will receive a \$1,500 course reconstruction stipend, high quality training and technical assistance, service-learning publications and resources, and support to attend the Massachusetts Department of Education's Annual Service-Learning Conference.

In accepting the award, faculty members agree to: 1) incorporate service-learning instruction into a spring semester course, 2) attend one full-day workshop, 3) host a departmental brown-bag lunch, and 4) complete an end-of-term report.
